19 This amendment removes the provisions in the bill that require the Department of
20 Health and Human Services to provide reimbursement to hospitals for MaineCare-eligible
21 individuals awaiting placement in a residential care facility. The amendment eliminates
22 the current maximum limit of \$500,000 a year for reimbursement to hospitals for
23 MaineCare-eligible individuals awaiting placement in nursing facilities. The amendment
24 also adds an appropriations and allocations section.
