1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §953-A, as enacted by PL 1999, c. 211, §1, is amended to read
3	§953-A. Document fees
4 5 6 7 8	A dealer selling a new or used motor vehicle shall post on the vehicle any document preparation fee that will be added to the vehicle's sale price. A dealer selling a new or used motor vehicle may not charge more than \$75 for a document preparation fee. A violation of this section is prima facie evidence of an unfair trade practice and is a violation of Title 5, section 207.
