Resolved: That, for the 2023 deer hunting season only, the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall establish, instead of a one-day youth deer hunting day, a 3-day youth deer hunting period beginning 8 days before the start of the 2023 regular deer hunting season.
32 33 34	Sec. 2. Examination. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall examine the impact of the 2 additional dedicated youth deer hunting days, as required by section 1, on the deer population, on the antlerless deer population and on the

department's ability to meet its wildlife management goals and shall examine the impact of
 youth deer hunting on Sunday.

Sec. 3. Report. Resolved: That, no later than March 1, 2024, the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall report to the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife the findings and recommendations of the examination under section of the 2 additional dedicated youth deer hunting days, including any recommended legislation, if needed. After receiving the report, the committee may report out a bill relating to youth deer hunting to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.

9 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation
 10 takes effect when approved.'

13 SUMMARY
14 This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve and does the following.
15 1. Current law provides for a one-day youth deer hunting day. The amendment

establishes a 3-day youth deer hunting period for 2023 to begin 8 days before the start of the regular deer hunting season.

 2. It directs the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to examine the impact
 19 of youth deer hunting on Sunday and the impact of 2 additional dedicated youth deer
 20 hunting days on the deer population, the antlerless deer population and wildlife
 21 management goals.

3. It directs the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to report to the Joint
 Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife the findings and recommendations
 of the examination and authorizes the committee to report out legislation on those findings
 to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.
