1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §4553, sub-§9-C, as enacted by PL 2005, c. 10, §3, is amended to read:
4 5	9-C. Sexual orientation. "Sexual orientation" means a person's actual or perceived heterosexuality, bisexuality, or homosexuality or gender identity or expression.
6	SUMMARY
7 8 9	This bill updates the definition of "sexual orientation" in the Maine Human Rights Act by removing the reference to "gender identity or expression." The term "gender identity" was given a separate definition by Public Law 2019, chapter 464.
