1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11152, sub-§9,</b> as enacted by PL 2021, c. 599, §11, is amended to read:
4 5 6 7	9. Fee. The fee for an antlerless deer permit is \$12 for residents and nonresidents. For a person with a valid senior lifetime hunting license under section 10851 or a complimentary license under section 10853, subsection 1 or 1-A, one antlerless deer permit must be provided at no cost.
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill eliminates the fee for one antlerless deer permit for holders of a senior lifetime hunting license or senior complimentary hunting license.
