29 30 31	This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment provides that a person commits a traffic infraction when operating while a license is suspended if the sole basis for suspension is failure to provide proof of insurance to the Secretary of State; failure to pay

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1 2	child support; failure to appear in court; or failure to comply with a medical examination request from the Secretary of State.
