1 **Sec. 1. Department of Health and Human Services to issue request for**
2 **proposals for quality child care services. Resolved:** That, no later than January 1,
3 2024, the Department of Health and Human Services shall issue a request for proposals to
4 establish a quality child care program for children from birth to 3 years of age in Kennebec
5 County in order to alleviate the long waiting lists for child care services. The child care
6 program must focus on play, movement, nutrition, social engagement and exploration with
7 toys and materials and provide education for parents on their children's development.

8 **Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved:** That the following
9 appropriations and allocations are made.

12 Initiative: Provides one-time funding for the start-up costs and expenses for the first year
