Amend the bill in section 1 in $\S 3028$-A in subsection 1 in the 6th line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "section" and inserting the following: 'subsection and must be handled in the manner required by section 2842-B'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:
'Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
