An Act to Support Individuals with Personality Disorder or Emotional Dysregulation by Requiring Reimbursement Under the MaineCare Program

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-KKK is enacted to read:

§3174-KKK. Reimbursement for treatment of personality disorder and emotional dysregulation

Beginning January 1, 2024, the department shall reimburse under the MaineCare program for the treatment of personality disorder and emotional dysregulation. The department shall establish a bundled reimbursement rate for the treatment of MaineCare members diagnosed with personality disorder or emotional dysregulation. In establishing the bundled reimbursement rate, the department shall consider various bundled reimbursement rate structures, including a daily rate and a monthly rate. The bundled reimbursement rate must include participation in a dialectical behavior therapy intensive outpatient program, psychiatry services, nursing services, case management, residential services, after-hours skills coaching and supported employment services.

SUMMARY

This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services, beginning January 1, 2024, to reimburse under the MaineCare program for the treatment of personality disorder and emotional dysregulation. The bill also requires the department to establish a bundled reimbursement rate for the treatment of MaineCare members diagnosed with personality disorder or emotional dysregulation.
