6	This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment exempts a credentialed
7	cardiovascular technologist from licensure under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32,
8	chapter 103, the Medical Radiation Health and Safety Act, when the cardiovascular
9	technologist is performing certain activities and acting under the delegated authority and
10	direct supervision of a physician while the physician is performing cardiac catheterization
11	or electrophysiology procedures.
