9 **§8001. Trauma-informed training and embedded clinical social workers program**

10 **1. Definitions.** As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise indicates, the  
11 following terms have the following meanings.

12 **A. "Trauma-informed training"** means training to recognize the presence of trauma  
13 **symptoms and acknowledge the role that trauma can play in people's lives, including**  
14 **by engaging with individuals with histories of trauma.**

15 **2. Training program and embedded clinical social workers.** The Department of  
16 **Public Safety shall develop and implement a program to provide law enforcement officers**  
17 **with trauma-informed training. The department shall work with municipalities to develop**  
18 **and implement a program to employ clinical social workers to work embedded within**  
19 **municipal police departments.**

20 **3. Rules.** The Commissioner of Public Safety may adopt rules to implement this  
21 **section. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in**  
22 **Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.**

23 **SUMMARY**

24 This bill requires the Department of Public Safety to develop and implement a program  
25 to provide law enforcement officers with trauma-informed training and requires the  
26 department to work with municipalities to develop and implement a program to employ  
27 clinical social workers to work embedded within municipal police departments.
