This amendment also requires a broader finding by the commission that the reorganization does not result in changes that would adversely affect safety, reliability or quality of service, unlike in the bill, which requires a finding that the reorganization would not result in changes that would adversely affect safety, reliability or quality of service as it pertains to the location and the accessibility of the telephone utility's management and operations or to the proportion and number of the telephone utility's employees who reside in the State.
