1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §410-N, sub-§4 is enacted to read:
3	4. Seine fishing in great ponds. If the department documents the occurrence of
4	invasive aquatic plants in a great pond, fishing in the great pond using a seine is
5	prohibited. For purposes of this subsection, "great pond" has the same meaning as in
6	section 436-A, subsection 7 and "seine" has the same meaning as in Title 12, section
7	<u>10001</u> , subsection <u>55</u> .
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill prohibits fishing using a seine in a great pond in which the Department of
10	Environmental Protection has documented the occurrence of invasive aquatic plants.
