## An Act to Require Registration of Motorized Bicycles or Tricycles or Motorized Scooters

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §351, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1999, c. 68, §1, is amended to read:
4 5 6	The owner of a vehicle that is operated or remains on a public way is responsible for registering the vehicle. For purposes of this section, "vehicle" includes a motorized bicycle or tricycle or motorized scooter.
7	Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §458-C is enacted to read:
8	§458-C. Motorized bicycle or tricycle or motorized scooter
9 10	A motorized bicycle or tricycle or motorized scooter may be registered in accordance with the provisions of this section.
11 12 13	<b><u>1. Registration fee.</u></b> The fee for a motorized bicycle or tricycle or motorized scooter registration is the same as the motor vehicle registration fee required under section 501, subsection 1.
14 15 16	<b>2. Registration plate.</b> The Secretary of State shall issue a registration certificate and a unique motorized bicycle or tricycle or motorized scooter registration plate in a 3-number and 3-letter combination sequence.

Application for registration.</b> An application for registration must contain information requested by the Secretary of State, including the legal name, residence and address of the registrant and the maker, the serial number if listed on the frame, the year of manufacture, the type of motor fuel or motive power and a brief description of the motorized bicycle or tricycle or motorized scooter. A registrant that is a corporation, trust, limited partnership or other similar entity shall provide either a federal taxpayer identification number or an identification number issued by the department. An initial application for registration must be signed by the registrant or the registrant's legal representative. The Secretary of State shall keep the initial application on file until that registration is terminated.
27 28	<b><u>4. Registration.</u></b> The registration must indicate the year and make of the motorized bicycle or tricycle or motorized scooter.
29 30	5. Vanity plates. The Secretary of State may not issue vanity plates for motorized bicycles or tricycles or motorized scooters.
31 32 33 34	<b>6. Inspection.</b> A motorized bicycle or tricycle or motorized scooter is not subject to the inspection requirements of section 1751, except that the Chief of the State Police may provide certain inspection requirements for motorized bicycles or tricycles or motorized scooters pursuant to section 1769.
35 36 37	7. Rules. The Secretary of State may adopt rules to enforce this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
