7 8 9	5. Vehicle. "Vehicle" means a motor vehicle, mobile home, <u>or</u> camper trailer, <u>heavierthan-air aircraft or lighter-than-air aircraft</u> . "Vehicle" does not include any snowmobiles as defined in Title 12, section 13001 <u>or aircraft</u> .

23 24	This bill repeals the annual excise tax imposed on aircraft and provides an explicit exemption from the excise tax for aircraft.
