The amendment amends a provision of law governing testing for HIV without consent to describe a source patient as an "incapacitated adult" and also clarifies that an HIV test may be conducted without consent when there is not a person available within 8 hours of the exposure who has legal authority to consent in time for the person who is exposed to receive appropriate medical treatment.
