Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Chapter 64: Maine School Facilities Program and School Revolving Renovation Fund, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Education and the Maine Municipal Bond Bank

- 1 **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
- 3 **Whereas,** the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A requires 4 legislative authorization before major substantive agency rules may be finally adopted by 5 the agency; and
- Whereas, a major substantive rule has been submitted to the Legislature for review;
  and
- 8 **Whereas**, immediate enactment of this resolve is necessary to record the Legislature's 9 position on final adoption of the rule; and

10 **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 11 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 12 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 13 therefore, be it

14 **Sec. 1. Adoption. Resolved:** That final adoption of portions of Chapter 64: Maine 15 School Facilities Program and School Revolving Renovation Fund, a provisionally adopted 16 major substantive rule of the Department of Education and the Maine Municipal Bond 17 Bank that has been submitted to the Legislature for review pursuant to the Maine Revised 18 Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A, is authorized.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation
 takes effect when approved.
