1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1904, sub-§6, as amended by PL 2005, c. 577, §25, is further amended to read:
4 5 6	6. Motorcycle. A motorcycle that does not have an adequate beam for headlights is restricted to daytime operation. <u>A motorcycle may be equipped with a low-beam headlight that is capable of flashing, the use of which is governed by section 2067, subsection 4.</u>
7	Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2067, sub-§4 is enacted to read:
8 9 10	4. Motorcycles; flashing low beam. Notwithstanding section 2054, subsection 2, paragraph A, the operator of a motorcycle equipped with a low-beam headlight that is capable of flashing may cause the headlight to flash during the daytime.
11	SUMMARY
12	This bill allows the operator of a motorcycle to use a flashing low-beam headlight
