1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1056, sub-§3, as amended by PL 2021, c. 514, §1, is repealed.
4 5	Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §1355-A, sub-§5, ¶F-1, as amended by PL 2021, c. 514, §2, is further amended by repealing the first blocked paragraph.
6	SUMMARY
7 8 9 10	This bill makes permanent the changes to the liquor laws, which are to be repealed March 30, 2025, allowing qualified on-premises retailers and qualified distilleries to sell liquor for off-premises consumption under certain conditions and the sale of cocktails for on-premises consumption at distilleries and small distilleries.
