15 16	' <b>Emergency preamble. Whereas,</b> acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
17 18 19	<b>Whereas,</b> Public Law 2021, chapter 735 requires the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to authorize certain off-premises sales of certain adult use cannabis products under the Cannabis Legalization Act; and
20	Whereas, the Act became effective January 1, 2023; and
21 22 23 24	Whereas, the Act requires statutory amendments that cannot be delayed in order to provide clarity for the Act's implementation and administration by the Department of Administrative and Financial Services and to provide clarity and certainty about the Act's requirements to adult use cannabis licensees and members of the public; and
25 26 27 28	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

26	SUMMARY
27 28	This amendment replaces the bill and changes the title. It amends the Cannabis Legalization Act by:
29 30	1. Creating new definitions for the terms "permitted premises for a specified event," "specified event" and "specified event permit";
31 32	2. Amending the application requirements for the issuance of a permit for cannabis stores to conduct sales at a specified event;
33 34	3. Changing the requirements for cannabis stores to account for authorized sales at a specified event;
35 36	4. Changing the limitations and conditions for cannabis stores to conduct sales at a specified event;
37 38	5. Establishing the criteria for the suspension or revocation of a permit for a cannabis store to conduct sales at a specified event;

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1 6. Providing criteria for the Department of Administrative and Financial Services' 2 approval or denial of a permit application for cannabis stores to conduct sales at a specified 3 event; 4 7. Repealing the department's rule-making authority regarding specified events which 5 is provided for under the department's general rule-making authority under this chapter; 6 and 7 8.
