## An Act to Exempt Certain Motor Vehicle Dealers from Display Area Size Requirements

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §851, sub-§4, </b> ¶ <b>C,</b> as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is repealed.
4 5	Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §952, sub-§1, ¶D, as amended by PL 2021, c. 216, §24, is further amended to read:
6 7	D. A suitable office in which business is conducted and records of the business are kept; and
8 9	<b>Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §952, sub-§1, </b> ¶ <b>E,</b> as amended by PL 2021, c. 216, §25, is further amended to read:
10 11	E. At least one mechanic, who may be the owner, who has a thorough knowledge of the vehicles being handled- <u>; and</u>
12	Sec. 4. 29-A MRSA §952, sub-§1, ¶G is enacted to read:
13 14 15	<u>G.</u> An improved display area of not less than 5,000 square feet in or immediately adjoining the applicant's established place of business. This paragraph does not apply if a dealer sells fewer than 50 vehicles annually.

17 18 19	This bill exempts a dealer that sells fewer than 50 vehicles annually from the requirement of maintaining an improved display area of not less than 5,000 square feet in or immediately adjoining its established place of business.
