1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §3062 is enacted to read:
3	§3062. Actions related to ownership of certain breeds of dogs prohibited
4 5 6 7	An insurance company authorized to transact business in this State may not cancel, refuse to issue or renew or charge an increased premium for a property insurance policy subject to this subchapter solely on the basis of a policyholder's ownership of a certain breed of dog.
8	SUMMARY
9 10 11	This bill prohibits the cancellation or nonrenewal of a property insurance policy solely on the basis of a policyholder's ownership of a certain breed of dog. The bill also prohibits an increase in the premium for the policy.
