The director may order an additional amount equal to the amount of unpaid wages as liquidated damages and a reasonable rate of interest only if the director finds that the violation was willful. To find willfulness, the director must prove by substantial evidence that the employer knew it was in violation of the law or acted with reckless disregard of the law.
