An Act to Allow the Reinstatement of Certain Commercial Driver's Licenses

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2523, sub-§2, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read: 3 4 B. For a 2nd or subsequent failure to submit to a test, the suspension is permanent, 5 except that after 10 years from the suspension, the person may request a hearing before the Secretary of State under section 2483 for a review and reinstatement for good cause 6 7 shown. 8 **SUMMARY** 9 This bill allows that a person whose commercial driver's license has been permanently 10 suspended due to a 2nd or subsequent failure to submit to a drug or alcohol test may after 10 years petition the Secretary of State for a review and reinstatement of that license for 11 12 good cause shown.
