An Act to Provide Uniform Protections from Retaliation for Maine Workers in Connection with the Exercise of Rights Protected Under the Laws Governing Employment Practices

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA c. 7, sub-c. 1-D is enacted to read:
3	SUBCHAPTER 1-D
4	GENERAL PROVISIONS
5	§620. Actions intended to prevent exercise of protected rights
6	An employer that takes action intended to prevent or penalize a person from exercising
7	rights protected under this chapter commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less
8	than \$500 nor more than \$1,000 for each violation may be adjudged, in addition to any
9	other remedy available under this chapter. The Department of Labor and the Attorney
10	General may file a civil action to enforce this section.
11	SUMMARY
12	This bill provides that an employer that takes action intended to prevent or penalize a
13	person from exercising rights protected under the laws governing employment practices
14	commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000 for
15	each violation may be adjudged, in addition to any other remedy available under the laws
16	governing employment practices. The Department of Labor and the Attorney General may
17	file a civil action to enforce the provisions of the bill.
