An Act to Require an Analysis Prior to the Start of State-funded Building Construction over \$1,000,000

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1754 is enacted to read:

§1754. New building construction

- 1. New state building construction. Prior to final approval of a construction project by the State of a new building that requires the expenditure of over \$1,000,000 in state funds, the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services, shall conduct an analysis under subsection 2. No state funds may be expended on a construction project under this subsection until the analysis under subsection 2 and the public hearing process under subsection 3 are completed.
- <u>2. Analysis.</u> An analysis conducted by the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services must examine whether:
 - A. The purpose of the proposed construction could reasonably be accomplished through the rehabilitation of an existing building that may be available and vacant;
 - B. The proposed construction or the rehabilitation of an existing building under paragraph A is located as closely as possible to a downtown area with a greater prevalence of services and transportation options than the proposed building location; and
 - C. It is feasible and is a more efficient use of space to incorporate housing into the new construction or rehabilitation project under paragraph A.
- 3. Public hearing. The analysis under subsection 2 must be released to the public upon its completion and a public hearing must be held within 30 days of its release to allow public inspection of and comment on the analysis.

23 SUMMARY

This bill requires the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services to conduct an analysis prior to final approval of the construction of any new building that requires the expenditure of over \$1,000,000 in state funds to determine whether an existing building can be rehabilitated to accomplish the same purpose as the new construction; whether a location closer to a downtown area with more services and transportation options than the proposed building location is available; and whether any housing can be incorporated into the new construction or rehabilitated existing building. This bill requires a public hearing to be held within 30 days of the release of the analysis to allow public inspection and comment.
