18 19 20	B. "Emergency action plan" means a document that provides guidelines to prepare school personnel to respond to a serious or life-threatening injury or medical emergency.
21 22	C. "Health care provider" means a physician licensed in this State with a scope of practice that includes prescribing medication.
23 24	D. "School" means a public elementary school or public secondary school, public charter school or private school approved for tuition purposes.

"Undesignated ready-to-use glucagon rescue therapy" means a glucagon rescue therapy approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration that does not require reconstitution for the treatment of severe hypoglycemia in a dosage form that can be rapidly administered to the patient in an emergency, including prefilled injectable or nasally administered glucagon, prescribed in the name of a school or school administrative unit as provided in this section.
31 32 33	F. "Unlicensed school personnel" means persons acting on behalf of the school who have completed the training required by rule to administer medication but do not possess a professional license that allows them to administer medication.'

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, provides that only a school nurse or unlicensed school personnel who have completed the training required by rule to administer medication may administer glucagon to a student. It also amends the definition of "health care provider" and "diabetes care plan," adds a definition for "emergency action plan" and removes the training that school employees may undergo.
