0	A. Pass in a lane not adjacent to that of the stationary vehicle, if possible; or
1 2	B. If passing in a nonadjacent lane is impossible or unsafe, pass the stationary vehicle at a careful and prudent speed reasonable for passing the vehicle safely.
3 4	Violation of this subsection is a traffic infraction for which a fine of not less than \$275 must be adjudged.'
