1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA c. 9, sub-c. 7 is enacted to read:
3	SUBCHAPTER 7
4	ELECTION FUNDING
5	<u>§871. Legislative approval</u>
6 7	1. Short title. This section may be known and cited as "the State Oversight of Election Funding Act of 2023."
8 9 10	2. Definition. As used in this section, "new federal election funds" means any federal funds received on or after October 1, 2023 by a person, group or entity charged by the State to administer an official election occurring within the State.
11 12 13 14	3. Notice requirement. A person, group or entity charged by the State to administer an official election occurring within the State that intends to accept or disburse new federal election funds shall provide notice to the Legislature of its intent to do so at least 30 days before accepting or disbursing the funds.
15 16 17 18 19	<u>4. Prohibition on acceptance or disbursement of federal election funds without</u> <u>state legislative approval.</u> New federal election funds must be approved by the Legislature before they may be accepted or disbursed by a person, group or entity charged by the State to administer an official election occurring within the State unless explicitly required by <u>state or federal law.</u>
20 21 22 23 24	5. Presumption of state legislative approval. It is presumed for purposes of compliance with this section that the Legislature has approved the acceptance and disbursement of new federal election funds if the Legislature fails to vote on the issue within 30 days from when notice is provided to the Legislature in accordance with subsection 3.
25 26 27 28	6. Construction. This section may not be construed to pertain to funding that already possesses an explicit state or federal legal requirement related to its acceptance and disbursement as of October 1, 2023 or funding provided under the federal Help America Vote Act of 2002.
29 30 31	7. Penalties. A person, group or entity that violates this section commits a civil violation for which a fine in the amount of the new federal election funds accepted or disbursed in violation of this section plus an additional \$1,000 may be adjudged.

33 34 35 36	This bill requires that new federal election funds be approved by the Legislature before they may be accepted or disbursed by a person, group or entity charged by the State to administer an official election occurring within the State unless explicitly required by state or federal law.
