2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15901, sub-§1-B is enacted to read:
3 4	<u>1-B. Emergency school construction project.</u> "Emergency school construction project" means a school construction project requiring the replacement of all or a significant
5	portion of a school facility that is declared uninhabitable by an authorized individual or an
6	authorized local, state or federal agency as a result of an unanticipated and sudden natural
7	or human-made disaster.
8	Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §15905, sub-§8 is enacted to read:
9 10 11	8. Emergency school construction project. The state board shall approve an emergency school construction project before a school construction project that is not an emergency school construction project.
12	SUMMARY
13	This bill requires the State Board of Education to approve an emergency school
14	construction project before a school construction project that is not an emergency school
15	construction project. The bill defines "emergency school construction project" as a school
16	construction project requiring the replacement of all or a significant portion of a school
17	facility that is declared uninhabitable by an authorized individual or an authorized local,
18	state or federal agency as a result of an unanticipated and sudden natural or human-made
19	disaster.
