Testimony of Rep. Walter Kumiega
Before the Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources
Presenting LD 490, An Act to Extend the Legal Hours for Harvesting Lobsters

Senator Baker and fellow members of the Committee on Marine Resources - I am Representative Walter Kumiega, serving Vinalhaven, North Haven, Isle au Haut, Stonington, Deer Isle, Southwest Harbor, Tremont, Swans Island, the Cranberry Isles and Frenchboro. I am here today to present LD 490, An Act to Extend the Legal Hours for Harvesting Lobsters.

Current law states that there is a nighttime closure for the lobster fishery during the period 1/2 hour after sunset until 1/2 hour before sunrise from June 1 to October 31, both days inclusive. This bill proposes to open harvesting 2 hours before sunrise in September and October only. This would give harvesters an additional 90 minutes of harvesting time during those 2 months of shorter days. 24-hour-a-day fishing starts November 1st.

Zone councils have the option to adopt a more restrictive opening time, so, if they wanted to keep the legal hours as they are now, that is a regionally controlled option.
