I am writing to you because I feel that the proposed legislation to allow Spring bear hunting is both unethical and not useful.

Maine has a long fall bear hunting season during which three methods of killing bears is legal. (Maine is the only state to allow so many ways to kill a bear). Adding another season means that bears have no life to live free of the threat of being hunted. Furthermore, hunting bears as they emerge from hibernation with young in tow is just cruel. If a mother is shot the young will die a slow and painful death from starvation.
