Hunters trap, hunt and bait bears. Now there is a request that a Spring Bear Hunt be allowed. Just in time for the Mother Bears to be taken away from the young- leaving them to be sentenced to certain death.

If you are concerned about the bear population- stop feeding them. That seems to be a major tenet of I.F. & W. Populations increase when there is a food source. It's illegal to bait deer. How was this baiting bill for bear, ever passed.

I.F. & W are charged with protecting the animal population, not supplying hunters with wildlife targets and making money off them. For instance, I was shocked when reading about the Moose Lottery. According to the paper, 54,000 requests came in for Moose Lottery Permits at \$15 each. Then , when the Lottery "Winners" are selected- they pay for permits ect. We're talking at least a million dollars - and that's just the moose hunt (slaughter).

Maine Guides are allowed to set up Baiting Stations- as long as they pay for all the hunting permits. Then they bring "arm chair hunters" in and allow them to shoot bears, as they feed on the donut piles that have been put out, to attract the bears. They charge each hunter, a thousand dollars, for their services.

Sporting??? I think not.

Historically, Maine has been a hunting State, but in 2019 -hunters are no longer the majority. Let's not turn them loose on Mother Bears.
