LD 654 Resolve, Directing the Office of Policy Innovation and the Future to Study Methods to Encourage the Development of Accessory Dwelling Units

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Resolve 2023, chapter 107 directs the Office of Policy Innovation and the Future to convene a group of stakeholders to study methods and develop model policy to encourage the development and construction of accessory dwelling units. The law also directs the office to submit a report, with findings and recommendations, to the Joint Select Committee on Housing no later than March 1, 2024. The law authorizes the Joint Select Committee on Housing to submit a bill to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.

LD 774 An Act to Require the Maine State Housing Authority to Report to the Legislature on the Housing Opportunities for Maine Fund

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 251 amends the law requiring the Maine State Housing Authority to submit a biennial report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over taxation matters covering the 2 prior fiscal years of the authority and requiring the committee to review the report by May 1st. The law requires the authority to submit the report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over housing matters, rather than taxation matters, annually. The law requires the report to not only provide a full accounting of how funds were spent in the prior fiscal year but also a detailed summary of how funds were spent in the prior 10 fiscal years.

LD 1289 An Act to Facilitate Property Redevelopment and Encourage Affordable Housing by Allowing the Conveyance of Unfinished Commercial Condominium Units

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 198 allows the conveyance of certain unfinished commercial condominium units to a purchaser or transferee for completion by the purchaser or transferee.

LD 1706 An Act to Clarify Statewide Laws Regarding Affordable Housing and Accessory Dwelling Units

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 192 makes changes to provisions of law regarding affordable housing and accessory dwelling units by:

LD 2 An Act to Address Chronic Homelessness by Creating the Housing First Fund

Although this bill was not enacted, the majority amendment to LD 2 as reported out by the Joint Select Committee was incorporated into LD 258, An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations from the General Fund and Other Funds for the Expenditures of State Government and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2023, June 30, 2024 and June 30, 2025, which became Public Law 2023, chapter 412.

The committee amendment to LD 2 established the Housing First Program within the Department of Health and Human Services to facilitate the delivery of stabilization and support services to residents of properties established or developed to provide permanent housing to persons who have been experiencing chronic homelessness and to fund technical assistance, administered by the Maine State Housing Authority, for the development of housing consistent with the program. The amendment required the department to ensure that funding supplements existing and future services provided under associated programs such as the MaineCare program and the housing outreach and member engagement provider program. The program is funded from the real estate transfer tax by depositing half of the funds that would otherwise be deposited into the General Fund into the Housing First Fund created by the amendment. The amendment authorized 2 positions within the Department of Health and Human Services under the Housing First Fund. The amendment directed the Department of Health and Human Services and the Maine State Housing Authority to jointly adopt rules to administer the program and requires them to report annually to the joint standing committee or joint select committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over housing matters for the purpose of evaluating the effectiveness of the program. The amendment also directed the Department of Health and Human Services to apply to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for state plan amendments to align certain MaineCare rules with the Housing First Program.

LD 226 An Act to Address Maine's Affordable Housing Crisis

LD 226, which was carried over on the Special Appropriations Table, was reported out of committee with a unanimous Ought to Pass as Amended recommendation (emergency). The committee amendment would have provided \$80 million to support programs administered by the Maine State Housing Authority to support homeownership for single-family homes and for first-time homebuyers and the development of affordable housing in the State. Initial funding for the programs would have come from the General Fund with ongoing funding from the Liquor Operation Revenue Fund. LD 258, An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations from the General Fund and Other Funds for the Expenditures of State Government and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2023,

June 30, 2024 and June 30, 2025, which became Public Law 2023, chapter 412, included a provision (see Part TT) providing \$70 million to the Maine State Housing Authority to fund the Rural Affordable Rental Housing Program and the Low-income Housing Tax Credit Program.

LD 492 An Act to Repurpose Vacant Shopping Mall and Retail Space to Mixed-use Housing and Retail

This bill was finally enacted in both the House and the Senate prior to the adjournment sine die of the First Special Session but was not signed by the Governor. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, the final disposition of this bill will be determined during the next legislative session.

LD 1609 Resolve, Directing the Department of Education to Develop a Pilot Program to Help Maine Students Avoid Homelessness

Although LD 1609 was not enacted, the amendment to LD 1609, was incorporated into LD 258, An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations from the General Fund and Other Funds for the Expenditures of State Government and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2023, June 30, 2024 and June 30, 2025, which became Public Law 2023, chapter 412 (see Part KKKK).

The committee amendment to LD 1609 directed the Department of Education to develop a 2-year pilot program to provide McKinney-Vento liaisons with access to emergency financial assistance funds for students at risk of homelessness. It provided \$3 million to be used to provide direct assistance, up to \$750, to students at risk of homelessness.

ordinances may be enacted by the municipal officers without further action or approval by the voters of the municipality and July 1, 2024 for all other municipalities;

- 2. Changing the definition of "affordable housing development" in the laws governing affordable housing density to provide that an affordable housing development is a development in which a household whose income does not exceed certain levels can afford 51% or more of the units in the development without spending more than 30% of the household's monthly income on housing costs;
- 3. Clarifying that municipal approval of an affordable housing development for purposes of timing of the execution of a restrictive covenant means granting final approval, including issuing an occupancy permit;
- 4. Clarifying that setback requirements are just one type of dimensional requirements;
- 5. Changing language stating where housing is allowed or permitted to refer to where residential uses, including as a conditional use, are allowed or permitted;
- 6. Clarifying that an accessory dwelling unit must comply with shoreland zoning requirements established by the Department of Environmental Protection and municipal shoreland zoning ordinances, except that a municipality may not categorically prohibit accessory dwelling units in the shoreland zone that would otherwise meet requirements established by the department and municipal shoreland zoning ordinances;
- 7. Allowing accessory dwelling units built without municipal approval, including accessory dwelling units in shoreland zones, if the accessory dwelling units otherwise meet state and municipal requirements for accessory dwelling units; and
- 8. Allowing municipalities to approve accessory dwelling units through a permitting process that does not require planning board approval.

Public Law 2023, chapter 192 was enacted as an emergency measure effective June 16, 2023.

LD 470 An Act to Support Lead Abatement in Older Residential Properties

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 435 provides one-time funds for the abatement of lead paint hazards in residential housing and for the cost of administering the lead abatement program under the Maine State Housing Authority.

LD 611 Resolve, Establishing a Working Group to Maximize Eligibility for Energy Efficiency Programs for Low-income Homeowners

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Resolve 2023, chapter 74 establishes a working group to be convened by the Maine State Housing Authority to develop a program that will provide financial assistance to low-income homeowners for weatherization and other repairs in order for the home to meet eligibility requirements for home energy assistance programs.

LD 724 An Act to Increase Opportunities for the Development or Preservation of Low-income Housing

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 218 makes changes to the law related to low-income housing and programs administered by the Maine State Housing Authority. Under current law, the Maine State Housing Authority has the right of first refusal to purchase low-income rental housing unless a bona fide buyer, by contract with the seller, agrees to maintain the property as low-income housing. The law removes reference to right of first refusal and provides that either the Maine State Housing Authority or a municipal housing authority has an option to purchase a low-income rental property with the municipal housing authority having the first option. The law clarifies that a failure by an owner to provide required notice of an intent to sell the property or take an action that would result in termination of income eligibility restrictions or rental restrictions does not reduce the time period within which the Maine State Housing Authority or a municipal housing authority has to provide in writing an intent to exercise the option to purchase the property. It also authorizes the assignment of the purchase option to a nonprofit corporation and extends the option period, to a time after the appraised value is agreed upon and to allow for the application for any necessary government approvals.

Public Law 2023, chapter 218 repeals the cap on the amount of outstanding principal on construction loan bonds held by the Maine State Housing Authority.

Finally, Public Law 2023, chapter 218 amends the law that governs state growth-related capital investments by permitting investment in a low-income housing project of 18 or fewer units for individuals with a household income of no more than 80% of the area median income.

LD 1844 An Act to Support Emergency Housing Construction and Renovation Statewide by Creating a Matching Grant Program

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 479 directs the Maine State Housing Authority to establish the Emergency Housing Matching Grant Program to provide grants to service providers to construct, acquire, renovate or lease buildings in order to provide emergency housing and shelter services. Applicants requesting grants

greater than \$100,000 must meet eligibility requirements to demonstrate that they can provide an appropriate level of services and provide funding from a source other than state funding to match the amount of the grant request on a one-to-one basis. When considering requests for proposals, the Maine State Housing Authority is required to award favorable points to proposals from applicants that will provide services in underserved areas and potentially reduce demand for emergency housing and shelter services in hubs for services. Public Law 2023, chapter 479 provides one-time funding to the Maine State Housing Authority in the amount of \$257,000 for the program.

LD 1931 An Act to Foster Stable and Affordable Home Ownership in Mobile Home Parks by Amending the Laws Relating to the Sale of Mobile Home Parks

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 378 changes current law regarding notice requirements when the owner of a mobile home park intends to accept an offer to purchase the park. Under this law, the owner of a mobile home park is required to give notice of the intent to sell the mobile home park to each mobile home owner of the mobile home park and to the Maine State Housing Authority. The park owner may not make a final unconditional acceptance of an offer to sell earlier than 60 days after the notice was provided. Within that 60 days, if a group or association of the owners of at least 51% of the mobile homes in the park sign a petition supporting an offer of purchase, the owner of the mobile home park must consider the offer and negotiate in good faith. Such an offer must include a purchase and sale agreement. If the mobile home park owner accepts the offer, the law provides for a 90-day period for the group or association of mobile home owners to secure financing.

Under this law, a violation of the requirement for notice of intent to sell or to negotiate in good faith is considered an unfair or deceptive trade practice.

Public Law 2023, chapter 378 provides for situations under which the notice and good faith negotiation requirements do not apply and also states that a mobile home park owner may send an affidavit of compliance to the county registry of deeds, the Maine State Housing Authority, or both.
