
OFPR Caseload Review through 2nd Quarter SFY 2018

MaineCare Caseload

MaineCare caseload data for FY 2018 released by the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of MaineCare Services (OMS) show aggregate MaineCare caseload continuing to decrease, with a slight increase in the most recent month. MaineCare caseload decreased by 3,524 persons (1.31%) over the last 12 months, or just under 300 persons per month.

The only significant increase over the last 12 months is in the Family Planning category (see Table 3 below). PL 2015 c.356 [An Act To Strengthen the Economic Stability of Qualified Maine Citizens by Expanding Coverage of Reproductive Health Care and Family Services] increased the federal poverty level (FPL) for family planning only services through MaineCare to 209%. The individuals entering MaineCare due to the increased FPL are in this new caseload category.

MaineCare Caseload Chart 1 shows OMS caseload data over time, while MaineCare Caseload Table 1 shows the caseload summary over that period. MaineCare Caseload Chart 2 shows OMS caseload data by membership group over the last 6 months, while MaineCare Caseload Table 2 shows the caseload detail with membership categories, membership groups and age categories over the last 6 months.


