The warehouse is not temperature-controlled and currently the refrigerators that are used to store the COVID-19 vaccine vials are inefficient when ambient temperatures are too high. The new modular temperature-controlled unit will offer more flexibility and mobility if the need to move the unit arises. This funding should help alleviate current issues with staffing and provide a short-term solution until all congregate care facility staff can be vaccinated.
