Bill "An Act to Protect Loons" (S.P. 333) (L.D. 1111) Came from the Senate, referred to the Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and Ordered Printed.

(The Committee on Reference of Bills had suggested reference to the Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry)

Was referred to the Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife in concurrence.

Non-Concurrent Matter

Bill "An Act to Ban Partial Birth Abortions" (H.P. 390) (L.D. 535) which was referred to the Committee on Judiciary in the House on January 28, 1997.

Came from the Senate ruled not properly before the Body in non-concurrence.

On motion of Representative AHEARNE of Madawaska, the House voted to Recede.

The SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes the Representative from Madawaska, Representative Ahearne.

Representative AHEARNE: Thank you Madam Speaker. Ladies and Gentlemen of the House. I move that the last four cosponsors listed on the cosponsor sheet be removed from L.D. 535. This merely needs to be done in order to comply with Joint Rule 206, which limits to eight cosponsors.

On further motion of the same Representative, pursuant to Joint Rule 206, the last four cosponsors listed were removed from the bill, in non-concurrence and sent up for concurrence.

Non-Concurrent Matter

Bill "An Act to Require Recommended Silvicultural Stocking Standards on Land Ownerships Enrolled under the Tree Growth Tax Laws" (H.P. 704) (L.D. 968) which was referred to the Committee on Taxation in the House on February 11, 1997.

Came from the Senate referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry in non-concurrence. The House voted to Recede and Concur.

Non-Concurrent Matter

Bill "An Act to Make the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife an Elected Position" (H.P. 698) (L.D. 962) which was referred to the Committee on State and Local Government and the Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife in the House on February 13, 1997.

Came from the Senate referred to the Committee on State and Local Government in non-concurrence.

The House voted to Recede and Concur.
