

“House Amendment “A””

Mr. IRVING of Caribou: For the purpose of later offering an amendment, I move that the vote be reconsidered whereby the resolve for an amendment to the Constitution providing for classification of property for the purposes of taxation, was assigned for hearing on March 25.

The motion was agreed to.

Mr. Irving then offered House Amendment A, by striking out after the word “proposed” in the third line thereof lines four to 11, inclusive, and inserting in place thereof the following: “Section 8 of Article IX of the Constitution is hereby amended by adding to said Section the following words: ‘but the Legislature shall have the power to levy a tax upon intangible personal property at such rate as it may deem wise and equitable without regard to the rate applied to other classes of property.’”

Mr. Irving then moved that the resolve and amendment be tabled for the amendment and be specially assigned for consideration on March 25.

The motion was agreed to.
