Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11224 is enacted to read:

§ 11224. Alien big game hunter; guide required

An alien may not hunt moose, deer or bear without being accompanied by a person who holds a valid guide license pursuant to chapter 927 authorizing that person to act as a hunting guide.

1. <u>Civil violation.</u> A person who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 may be adjudged.

2. Class E crime. A person who violates this section after having been adjudicated as having committed 3 or more civil violations under this Part within the previous 5-year period commits a Class <u>E crime.</u>'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and is similar in requiring a person who is not a citizen of the United States to be accompanied by a licensed guide but specifically applies to hunting moose, deer or bear. The amendment also provides penalties for violations of the provision.
