## An Act To Increase the Value of an Estate Collectible by Affidavit in Probate Law to \$20,000

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

**Sec. 1. 18-A MRSA §3-1201, sub-§(a), ¶(1),** as enacted by PL 1979, c. 540, §1, is amended to read:

(1). The value of the entire estate, wherever located, less liens and encumbrances, does not exceed  $\frac{10,00020,000}{20,000}$ ;

## SUMMARY

This bill increases the amount of personal property of a decedent's estate that can be collected by affidavit from \$10,000 to \$20,000.
