## **An Act To Clarify Certain Equipment Provisions for Motor Vehicles**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1901**, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

### **§ 1901. General restriction**

~~A person may not use, sell or equip a vehicle with a lens, muffler, reflector, lighting device, window-tinting material or other~~ a vehicle with aftermarket equipment on a public way contrary to this Title ~~or~~ contrary to the rules of the Chief of the State Police.

### **SUMMARY**

This bill amends the equipment laws for motor vehicles by removing the specific list of aftermarket equipment prohibited and removing the prohibition on the sale of or equipping a motor vehicle with aftermarket equipment, and limits the prohibition on use of a motor vehicle with aftermarket equipment to use on a public way.
