Amend the amendment in section 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 19 in amendment) by striking out the following: "let." and inserting the following: 'let such private homes must post in a visible location in each rented room a card with the following statement in text that is easily readable in no less than 18-point boldface type of uniform font "This lodging place is not regulated by the State of Maine Department of Health and Human Services, Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention." The homes must provide guests upon check-in with a notice containing the same information.'

### SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that private homes that are not considered lodging places and are not subject to licensing must post in a visible location in each rented room a card informing the public that the lodging place is not regulated by the Department of Health and Human Services, Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention, and must provide guests upon check-in with a notice containing the same information.
