An Act To Encourage Municipal Cooperation

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2304, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 737, Pt. A, §2 and Pt. C, §106 and amended by PL 1989, c. 6; c. 9, §2; and c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further amended to read:

§ 2304. Tax status

Regional councils established in accordance with this Title are tax-exempt institutions ~~which~~that are exempt only from income and sales taxes, except for the provisions of Title 36, section 651, subsection 1, paragraph H.

Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §651, sub-§1, ¶D is amended to read:

D. The property of any public municipal corporation of ~~this~~the State appropriated to public uses, ~~if~~whether located within the corporate limits and confines of ~~sue~~the public municipal corporation or within the corporate limits and confines of another public municipal corporation.

Sec. 3. 36 MRSA §651, sub-§1, ¶H is enacted to read:

H. The property of a regional council under Title 30-A, chapter 119 formed by 2 or more municipalities to promote intergovernmental cooperation.

SUMMARY

This bill exempts from the property tax municipal property located in another municipality and the property of a regional council formed by 2 or more municipalities to promote intergovernmental cooperation.
