Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Sec. 1 Transfer. Resolved: That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, no later than September 15, 2007 the State Controller shall transfer \$49,868 from the Carrying Balances, General Fund account within the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to the Maine State Parks Development Fund, Other Special Revenue Funds account within the Department of Conservation, and no later than September 15, 2008 the State Controller shall transfer \$53,426 from the Carrying Balances, General Fund account within the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to the Maine State Parks Development Fund, Other Special Revenue Funds account within the Department of Conservation; and be it further
