Amend the amendment in section 2 in chapter 16-D in §1691 in subsection 10 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 25 in amendment) by striking out the following: "product." and inserting the following: 'product, except that when 2 brand names are affixed to the consumer product the actual manufacturer of the consumer product is considered the manufacturer.'

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the definition of "manufacturer" to clarify that if there are 2 brand names affixed to the consumer product, the actual manufacturer of the consumer product is considered the manufacturer.
