Amend the bill by striking out all of section 5 (page 2, lines 1 to 11 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

- 'Sec. 5. Transfer of funds. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Controller shall transfer \$600,000 in fiscal year 2008-09 from the Bureau of Medical Services, Federal Block Grant Fund account to the Fund for a Healthy Maine no later than June 30, 2009 to fund the Department of Health and Human Services, Bureau of Health's comprehensive cancer screening, detection and prevention program.
- **Sec. 6. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.
