Amend the bill in section 8 in §2666 by striking out all of subsection 1 (page 3, lines 34 and 35 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'1. Employment; communicable disease. No person having a communicable disease may be employed or work at a public swimming pool or spa.'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the bill by repealing the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 2666, subsection 1, which prohibits a person having a communicable disease from working at a public pool or spa.
