Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act To Require the Teaching of Franco-American History as Part of Maine History'**

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 4th line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Acadian" and inserting the following: 'Franco-American'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

**'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.
