An Act To Increase the Retirement Age for New State Employees to 65 Years of Age

CONCEPT DRAFT SUMMARY

This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

This bill proposes to impose a retirement age of 65 years of age for those employees participating in the Maine Public Employees Retirement System who have not yet vested.
