#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This legislation creates a combined license for agency liquor stores that also sell beer and wine. Currently, the total of the licenses required in this situation equals \$700 with a \$10 registration fee. This bill retains the \$700 license fee and reduces the occurrence of the \$10 registration fee. It is assumed that 90% of agency liquor stores would opt for this new license, resulting in a decrease in General Fund revenues of \$4,050 beginning in fiscal year 2011-12.
